Each spring, the Afro-Americans for an Academic Society (AAAS) recognize students who have consistently achieved academic excellence throughout their education. CH2M purchased computers for two college-bound students who have achieved at least a 3.0 GPA for nine consecutive years.



CH2M was also a bronze sponsor for the Hispanic Academic Achievers Program (HAAP) in April. The HAAP program provides scholarships to deserving Hispanic students to attend college or a university. In 2016, 25 graduating high school seniors received scholarships totaling \$65,000 at the annual ceremony.

Support Advocacy & Resource Center raises funds for Kids Haven

CH2M supported Cinco de Mayo, the Kids Haven Benefit Auction, at the Richland Community Center where 140 attendees raised almost \$20,000. Kids Haven is a program designed to meet the needs of children who have allegedly been physically and/or sexually abused. It is a joint effort between SARC and our local and county governments.

MS Walk participation increases

CH2M had **18 volunteers** walk for a combined **54 hours**, raising nearly **\$3,000** in support of Walk MS 2016. Overall there were **100** more walkers this year over last, and more than **\$27,500** was raised at the Tri-Cities walk in April to support cutting-edge research and life-changing programs and services.



Relay for Life raises money for cancer
 The Relay for Life Columbia River Event had 39 teams and 483 participants this year. Team CH2M raised **\$3,000** of the more than \$65,000 with **22 volunteers** walking for more than **57 hours** throughout the evening and night.



Great Strides is Cystic Fibrosis Foundation's largest fundraising event

Nearly **\$55,000** was raised at the annual Cystic Fibrosis (CF) Great Strides Walk in Richland. CH2M was part of Team Nathan with Rene Finke as the lead. Nathan is Renee's nephew, and Renee' has been walking for CF for 16 years, since Nathan was just weeks old. Research has discovered a couple of drugs that have had very positive results for patients, including Nathan! Team Nathan, with more than 35 walkers and many more donors, contributed nearly \$34,000 of the total for the Richland event.

Golf Tournaments raise awareness and funds for local organizations
CH2M participates in many golf tournaments in various ways throughout the year. This quarter CH2M was a part of the **Children's Developmental Center** Golf for Children, **Washington State University** Columbia Crimson Golf Classic, **Hanford Fire Department Muscular Dystrophy Association** and **Operation Thank You** golf tournaments.
