Acceptable Forms of Identification for Access to the Hanford Site

Acceptable Forms of Photo Identification

Note 1: Only ONE form of identification is required if photo ID is from the following list.

Note 2: Original or certified copy of documents only. No expired or cancelled documents.

- Standard driver's license* (See exception below)
- State-issued ID card* (See exception below)
- Enhanced driver's license
- U.S. passport (book or card)
- U.S. Military or a U.S. Military dependent's ID card
- ID card issued by a U.S. government agency or entity, including
 - Native American tribal ID,
 - Transportation Worker ID Card (TWIC)
- PIV Card (aka HSPD-12 badge)

***EXCEPTION:** If the standard driver's license or state-issued ID card is from a non-REAL ID compliant state, you will need to present a second ID from the list below. Non-compliant states are: Washington, Arizona, Idaho, Louisiana, Maine, Minnesota, New Hampshire, New York, Oklahoma or American Samoa.

Acceptable Second Forms of Identification

Note: Original or certified copy of documents only. No expired or cancelled documents.

- U.S. Social Security Card
- Birth Certificate, Original or certified copy with seal, issued by a government entity (State, county, municipality, etc.) Note: Hospital birth certificates not allowed.
- Hanford Site Specific Badge (Green, Black, Red, or Brown)
- ID card issued by a federal, state, or local government agency or entity
- Voter's registration card
- U.S. Coast Guard Merchant Mariner Card
- Certificate of U.S. Citizenship (Form N-560 or N-561)
- Certificate of Naturalization (Form N-550 or N-570)
- U.S. Citizen ID Card (Form I-197)
- Certification of Birth Abroad (Form FS-545)
- Certification of Report of Birth issued by the Department of State (Form DS-1350)
- Native American tribal document or ID card

Examples of Unacceptable Identity Source Documents

- Hospital birth certificates
- Student ID cards or school ID cards
- Library cards
- Weapons permits
- Photocopies of documents that are not certified
- Notarized copies of documents
- Any expired or cancelled identity source documents
