Subject: PRACTICE COVID CONTROLS

As we have seen increasing numbers of COVID-19 cases across the country, state, region and local community, I need your help.

At work, we don't act until we are confident we can perform the work safely. Please adopt that perspective with your health. If you aren't sure of your health or aren't sure if you may have been exposed to COVID-19, don't come to work.

The CHPRC and Hanford workforce have an outstanding safety record. We practice safety 24/7 – taking the safety practices that we use here at work home to help keep our friends and families safe. Please do the same thing with the COVID-19 controls we use here at work.
